Londonderry Port and Harbour recognises that travel is associated with our business activities and that our employees have a direct impact on the environment, particularly through vehicle emissions, fuel consumption and our impact on local congestion. Inefficient business travel also results in significant and unnecessary costs to our business.

Londonderry Port and Harbour is committed to encouraging the use of more sustainable forms of transport across our operations. In order to implement this commitment we have established the following objectives. We will:

- Reduce dependency on car travel to essential business users
- Encourage the use of videoconferencing and teleconferencing.
- Encourage multiple occupancy car use
- Londonderry Port and Harbour is promoting cycling to work by offering employees the opportunity to take part in the Governments cycle to work scheme. Details are available at
