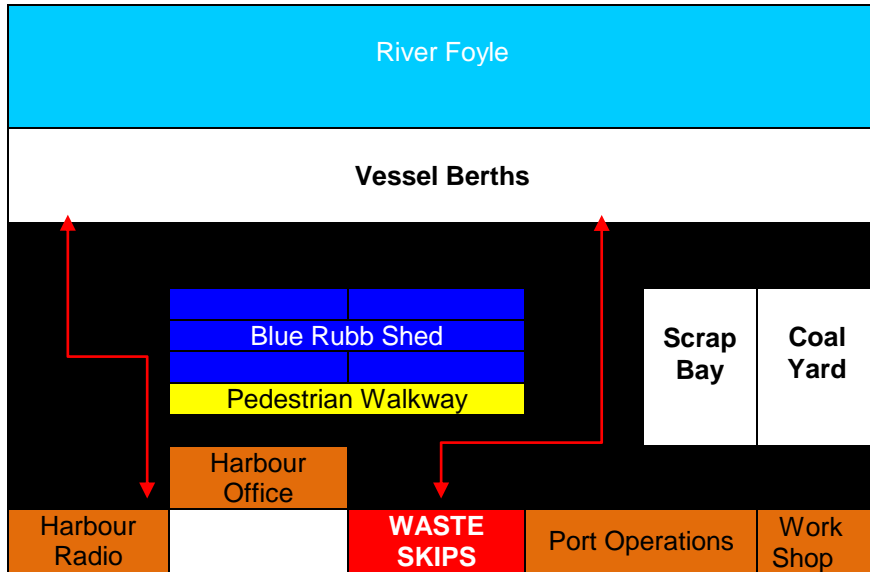


### General Map

## **WASTE CONTROL**

### **Galley Waste & Non-Galley Waste**

Garbage must be segregated into Galley Waste & Non-Galley Waste. Two Garbage Skips; one for Galley Waste and one for Non-Galley Waste are located outside Port Operations.

### **Galley Waste**

Galley Waste refers to waste of animal origin and from products of animal origin. This includes meat, milk, cheese, animal fats, fish, honey and any other product made with a product of animal origin, or derived from one (such as gelatine) EU Directive 1774/2002

Galley Waste must be placed into the locked blue skip. A key may be obtained at either Port Operations or Harbour Radio. The key must be signed for upon issue and upon return.

### **Non-Galley Waste**

This includes packaging, banding, paper and plastics. Paint tins, oily rags, filters and batteries MUST NOT be put in the Galley waste skip, but segregated and landed separately in skips provided. Notify your agent or the terminal operator for further information..

### **Scrap Metal**

A separate skip is available outside Port Operations for the disposal of scrap metal.

### **Waste Wood / Donnage**

Should a vessel wish to discharge waste wood / donnage; the ship's agent should contact Port Operations to arrange for its collection.

### **Dirty Ballast Water/Bilge Water/Sewage Sludge**

These are discharged by road tanker. Contact your ships agent for details.

### **Charges**

A levy of **£0.03** is charged per gross registered tonne. This covers the disposal of Galley and Non-Galley waste. The disposal of other waste material is charged separately.

### **Notice**

In order to negotiate the most cost efficient and expedient facilities for you, it would be helpful if you could give 24 hours notice of your requirements to your agent, and at least 2 hours notice to the Port of Londonderry Harbour Office.

### **Grievances**

If you find any deficiency in the system or feel that excessive charges have been levied, please contact the Harbour Master.
